



Richard "Dickie" Lynn Schilhab

October 13, 1949 - April 21, 2015

A memorial service for Richard L. "Dickie" Schilhab, also affectionately known as "Dude", 65, of Tyler, will be held on Saturday, April 25, 2015 at 1:00 PM at Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception under the direction of Stewart Family Funeral Home. Bishop Joseph Strickland will officiate.

Mr. Schilhab, a graduate of Texas Tech University passed away Tuesday, April 21, 2015 in Tyler after a short battle with cancer.

He was born October 13, 1949 in Victoria to Lawrence C. and Virginia Greive Schilhab.

Dickie was a member of the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception Church and a Third Degree Knight of the Knights of Columbus, a member of Texas Tech Epsilon Phi Delta Theta and the Texas Aggregate and Concrete Association (TACA). Dickie was preceded in death by his father Lawrence C. Schilhab and brothers, Tim and Jeff Schilhab.
