



## Richard "Red" Vivian Gaiser

January 19, 1921 - February 1, 2016

Mr. Gaiser passed away Monday, February 1, 2016 in Tyler.

He was born January 19, 1921, in Smith County near Camp Fannin to the late William Ollie and Willie Walsh Gaiser. He married Willie Mae McKinney on November 3, 1941, spending 68 wonderful years together. He was a member and Deacon of Flint Baptist Church.
