Services for Robert M. Booth, 71, of Tyler, will be held on Saturday, February 25, 2012 at 11:00 AM at Stewart Family Funeral Home Chapel with John Prestridge officiating. Visitation will begin at 10:00 AM, 1 hour prior to the service. Burial will follow at Cathedral in the Pines Cemetery in Tyler. Mr. Booth passed away February 21, 2012 under the care of Hospice of East Texas. He was born April 22, 1940 to Joseph Robert and Bertha Johanna Booth in Anaconda, Montana. Robert served in the US Air Force as a fighter pilot during the Vietnam War. After the war, he taught other pilots as a pilot instructor. Major Booth retired after serving 20 years. Later Robert attended and graduated from Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary in Ft. Worth. He then served as Associate Pastor at Southside Baptist Church in Wichita Falls, Sr. Pastor of Fellowship of Prairie Creek Church in Lindale, and as Associate Pastor at Pleasant Hills Baptist Church in Tyler. After serving as a minister for 25 years, Robert once again retired for a second time. He was a current member of Grace Community Church. Mr. Booth is survived by his loving family including his wife of 50 years. Carole Booth of Tyler, daughter Karen Booth of Wichita Falls, and son Robert Booth of Flint; sister, JoAnn Guadnola of Phoenix, AZ; and by grandchildren Hayle Booth of Frankston and Jaxon Booth of Flint.
