Obituary for Robert Pensinger

Robert F. Pensinger, 74, of Bullard, passed away Friday, July 18, 2014 in Tyler, Texas.

Mr. Pensinger will be interred with military honors at Dallas-Ft. Worth National Cemetery on Thursday, July 24, 2014 at 11:00 AM.

A memorial service for Mr. Pensinger will be held on Friday, July 25, at 11:00 AM at Flint Baptist Church in Flint with Rev. Sam DeVille officiating. Visitation with the family will be held one hour prior to the memorial service from 10:00 to 11:00 AM at the church.

Mr. Pensinger was born February 20, 1940, in Chicago Heights, IL, to Frank M. and Margery E. Pensinger. Following Robert's graduation from Bloom Township High School, he joined the U. S. Navy where he became a 2nd Class Petty Officer and was decorated with a Good Conduct Medal. He later earned an Associate Degree in Applied Science from Thornton Community College in South Holland, IL. For twenty-two years, he worked for The Amoco Corporation, moving up in the employment ranks to Building Manager for the company's 83-story building.

Known as "Bob" by his family and friends, he was active in Flint Baptist Church, through his participation in worship, Sunday school, Personnel Committee, Building Committee, Monday Work Crew, Men's Prayer Group, mission trips, Bible studies, and other church activities.

In addition to diligently reading the Bible, he enjoyed travel, refinishing furniture, and collecting antique clocks. He was a member of the Chapter 419 Ramblin' Pushers Motorhome Club and The Chapter 214 Ramblin' Rangers Travel Club.

Mr. Pensinger is survived by his wife of 30 years, Karen Pensinger; his mother, Margery Pensinger of Tyler; son Michael Pensinger and wife Beth, of Crete, IL; son David Pensinger of Chicago Heights, IL; grandson Zachary Pensinger of Crete, IL; brother John Pensinger and wife Lee of Punta Gorda, FL; and sister Donna Hank and husband Doug of Foxboro, WI.

Robert Pensinger was preceded in death by his father, Frank Pensinger. The family wishes to express gratitude to the Hospice of East Texas for the exceptional care that was provided during Bob's illness.
