



Roger M. Nygaard

November 30, 1936 - April 24, 2014

A Memorial Service for Roger M. Nygaard, 77, of Flint, will be held on Thursday, May 1, 2014, at 11:00 AM at Our Saviour's Lutheran Church in Tyler with Dr. Mark Braaten officiating under the direction of Stewart Family Funeral Home.

Mr. Nygaard passed away Thursday, April 24, 2014.

He was born November 30, 1936 in Webster, South Dakota to Melvin Sigfred and Ruth Janette Stevenson Nygaard.

Roger worked for many years with the Chamber of Commerce as an Executive Vice President and President and as a Development Coordinator with the Salvation Army in Grand Island, Nebraska. For the last 6 years he has worked part time at Hollytree Country Club as a Marshall and Starter. Roger also served as past President for the Bullard Rotary Club and was a former Director of Goodwill Industries and past Chairman of the Board for The Institute for Organizational Management. He was a member of Our Saviour's Lutheran Church in Tyler, Texas where he has been president of the church council for the last 2 ½ years.

Roger was preceded in death by his parents and sister, Carole Timmons.
