



Samuel "Curt" Lindsay

Mr. Lindsay passed away peacefully on Monday, March 23, 2015.

He was born August 19, 1932 in Chickasha, Oklahoma as the youngest child to Joseph D. Lindsay and Florence Wasserbeck.

Curt attended Oklahoma State University, graduating in 1957. Upon graduation, he entertained a successful career as a naval aviator, flight instructor and intelligence officer. Upon retirement from military service he served the Federal Aviation Administration as an Aerospace inspection pilot, culminating in an aviation career spanning 44 years of service.

He is survived by his loving family including wife of 55 years, Shirley; three sons, Joe Lindsay and wife Lisa, Curt Lindsay and wife Kathryn, and Kelly Lindsay; six grandchildren, Joey, Sam, Jackson, Claudette, Holden and Madeline; and extended family and many friends.

“ Shirley, you caught me off guard this morning with the news Curt had passed. Please accept my deepest sympathy for you and your entire family. I sure do have many good memories of the short time he was my boss. I first met him in VX-6 where he flew the plane I was assigned to while my regular pilot was ill. I then had a stint being on his crew at NAS Corpus on the Admirals plane. That duty was cut much shorter than I had hoped. It happened that way because I had volunteered for Vietnam in April 1965. June of 1965 Curt came down to the squadron I was in and asks if I would like to go up on the Admirals Aircraft. Of course that was a definite yes. Forgetting all about volunteering for Vietnam in late October we were getting ready to take Admiral Brandley to San Antonio and the yeoman came down to the plane and informed me my orders were in and within hours I was checked out and gone. I hold very high respect for Curt; he was an excellent officer, pilot and a super boss.
