A memorial service for Sarah “Katherine” Brown, 38 of Tyler, will be held on Saturday at 2:00 PM at Stewart Family Funeral Home Chapel with Rev. Scott Mackey and Rabbi Neal Katz officiating. Katherine passed away February 26, 2012. She was born July 12, 1973 in Tyler to Warren Corder and Carolyn Anne Burnett Brown. Katherine was a 1991 graduate of Robert E. Lee High School.
