



## Sharon Jayne Bragg

August 25, 1943 - May 3, 2025

Mrs. Sharon Jayne Bragg, 81, passed away on Saturday, May 3, 2025, in Tyler, surrounded by her beloved family. She was born on August 25, 1943, in Palestine, Texas, to Hayden Daniel Trigg and Rubye Elizabeth Broughton Trigg.

Sharon graduated from Palestine High School and went on to attend Sam Houston State University. She enjoyed a long and fulfilling career with Texaco Chemical in Houston, after which she and her husband, Clyde, retired and made their home in Tyler.
