What a beautiful, kind spirit, in Sharon that I will remember smiling, and dedicated to one of the prettiest young ladies I watched grow up, Danyelle.

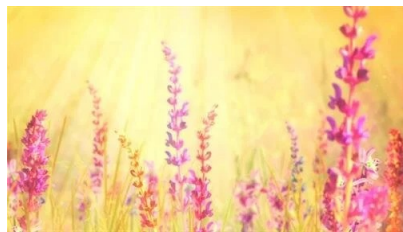
