A Memorial Service to honor the life of Stephen Anthony Hurst, 65, of Tyler will be held at 2 p.m. Saturday, Aug. 21st at the Green Acres Baptist Church Chapel, under the direction of Stewart Family Funeral Home. Dr. Darryl Dunks will officiate. The family will receive friends following the service. Steve joined our Lord on Monday, Aug. 16, 2010 at Vanderbilt University Medical Center, Nashville, TN due to injuries suffered in a tragic car accident. Steve was a very caring husband, father and grandfather who loved his family greatly. He was filled with the Holy Spirit and his love for Jesus showed in his actions every day. Steve was born on May 23, 1945, in Los Angeles. He was a graduate of Leggett Valley High School, California. He was also a graduate of the University of Nebraska. He served in the United States Air Force for 26 years, achieving the rank of CMSGT. He received numerous military awards including a defense meritorious service medal with one bronze oak leaf cluster, a meritorious service medal with two bronze oak leaf clusters and an Air Force commendation medal. He moved to Tyler in 2003 and was an active member of Green Acres Baptist Church. He worked at Hall Buick Pontiac GMC until 2009. He is survived by his wife of 44 years, Janice Kay Hurst. He is also survived by daughter, Dr. Michele Chai and husband, Dr. Jonathan Chai, daughter, Terri Good and husband, Ken Good; grandchildren, Nicholas Chai, Benjamin Chai, Madeleine Chai, Darby Good, and Laurel Good; step-mother, Jacqueline Hurst; sister, Linda Boote; brother, Scott Hurst; half-brother, Lynn Hurst; and brother-in-law, Robert Nichols.
