



## Stephen Bertrand Kittrell

March 9, 1956 - January 31, 2018

Stephen Bertrand Kittrell passed away Wednesday, January 31, 2018 at The Hospice of East Texas. He was born March 9, 1956 in Tyler, Texas, the youngest son of Martha Scott and Edwin N. Kittrell Jr., of Tyler.

Steve attended Marvin United Methodist Church and Tyler public schools, graduating from Robert E. Lee where he served as a Lee Gentleman.
