



## Susanna "Susie" Redford

June 12, 1938 - November 11, 2015

Susanna "Susie" Weatherford Redford passed away on November 11, 2015 after a lengthy battle with cancer. Born in Dallas on June 12, 1938, to Gladys Stough and Lynn Charles Weatherford, she joined the third generation of Weatherfords in Dallas.

Susie graduated from Hillcrest High School in 1955 and attended Texas Tech University where she met William "Willie" Redford. They were married almost 59 years. Susie and Willie began their family in Dallas, eventually moving to Tyler, where they raised their two children.
