Tyler, Texas- Susie Elizabeth Hill passed into God's eternal loving hands on 8 August, 2006, after she suffered a massive terminal stroke at the age of 63 years and six months. Susie was born 8, March 1943, in Biloxi, MS. She was the daughter of William and Helen Case who preceded her in death. Susie and her husband, Stanley built their home in Tyler in December 2002 where they retired. Susie retired after many years from Loral Software as the Support Manager.
