The couple also enjoyed traveling for business together, watching Netflix movies, and talking about their plans for the future. However, most of their activities revolved around the boys. 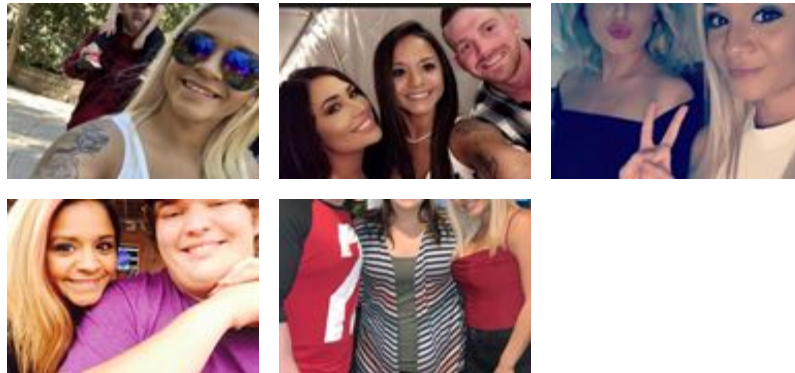
