Memorial services for Virginia Vanette Statham Boshears, 72 of Tyler, will be held on Sunday, January 14, 2018 at 1:00 PM at Glenwood Church of Christ.

Vanette passed from this worldly life to the arms of her Creator on Thursday, January 11, 2018 at Hospice of East Texas. She was born on June 8, 1945 in Tyler, Texas to Van and Arline Mallory Statham.

She was a 1963 graduate of John Tyler High School where she was a member of the Blue Brigade, 1967 graduate of Stephen F.
