August 13, 1968 - October 1, 2010

Von Swann, 42, of Farmington, New Mexico, formerly of Tyler, lost his short battle of illness on October 1, 2010. He was baptized as one of Jehovah's Witnesses in July 1985. Now he is in the memory of his loving heavenly Father, Jehovah. He was born August 13, 1968 in Tyler Texas. After graduating from John Tyler High School in 1987, in 1991 he moved to the Four Corners area and went to work for various oilfield companies leading to the start of his own his company, Swann's Extractions. He is survived by the love of his life, Jessica Swann, his wife of 18 years. They were married on October 24, 1992. Von is also survived by his parents: Billy Ray and Clareen Swann of Tyler, TX and sisters: Vicki Swann of Colorado and Vanessa Swann of California; also many uncles, aunts, cousins and a host of friends. He was preceded in death by his sister Yvette Swann Bass of Tyler in November 2008. A Memorial Service for Von will be held Saturday, October 9, 2010 at 1:00 p.m. at Stewart Family Funeral Home Chapel, 7525 Old Jacksonville Hwy, Tyler, TX officiated by Edward Anderson of the White Rock Congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses, Dallas, TX. A memorial service will also be held on the same day in Farmington, NM for his family and friends there. “ I traveled with Von overseas to many different places. He always was smiling and cutting up. He always kept me laughing. I will never forget the time I was in Indonesia in a very hostile camp. I had spoken to Von and he was still in LA. I told him how bad it was and he said "hold on little buddy, the "Duck" is on his way to rescue you. Sure enough his first day on a transport boat they put a container of bombs right in between Von and I. A kid about 16 years old boarded the boat with an m-16 machine gun and Vonn looked at me and said "what the hell goin on" "this aint gonna happen captain". I couldnt do anything but laugh. He thought the kid was going to shoot us because I couldnt quit laughing. When we made it to camp out on an island in the middle of the Mahakam river in the Mahakam Delta our boat was met by "gaurds" holding M-16 machine guns. Von says "Ben...I dont like the way they are looking at us. I dont think they have ever seen a Black man". Once again I busted out laughing. The gaurds got us off the boat and litterally pushed us to a room butting us with the guns. They then kept a goon in front of our room to ensure we didnt leave the room. Von got on the satellite phone and called BJ and said get us out of there. this is only a small part of the story, but needless to say we were back on a boat the next morning and we never went back. I just found out that Von had passed. I love you my brother. Von had so much class. Would somebody from the family please call or email. I cant rest without asking a few questions.
