Goforth officiating. Burial will follow at Cathedral in the Pines Cemetery. Keith went to be with the Lord on November 5, 2007. He was born August 8, 1966 in Tyler to Kenneth and Ouida Jacobe. Keith, better known as "BoBo" to his grandson and nephew, was Vice President of Construction Operations for Jacobe Brothers Construction in Tyler. In the last several years he has overseen the building of numerous churches and commercial structures throughout the regional area. He was active in the music ministry of Tyler Gospel Chapel, which took him to many locations including the Bahamas where he taught music fundamentals to people of all classes and ages. He used his musical talent to bless many lives by providing music for a countless number of occasions.
