Th Wesley William Stutts, 92, passed peacefully on to be with his Lord and Savior on Monday, April 29th, 2013 in the care of Hospice of East Texas. He was surrounded by his beloved wife and children. Born in Davis, Oklahoma, he was the son of the late Tom Allen and Nettie Autry Stutts.

Mr. Stutts graduated from Kerens High School in 1938 and then went on to serve in the 36th division in World War II where he was a Staff Sergeant. He married the love of his life, Flora Burgin, on February 2, 1947 in Longview, Texas. Wesley was a senior operator for Exxon Mobil Oil Company, and retired after 41 years. Mr. Stutts was known for his compassionate heart, often putting others needs before his own. He was a loving husband, father, grandfather and friend.
