William J. Bacile, 79, of Tyler, passed away on Monday, April 20, 2009 in Tyler. A rosary will be held on Friday, April 24, 2009 at 11:30 AM with a mass to follow at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Tyler with Monsignor Joseph Strickland officiating.

Mr. Bacile was born on February 5, 1930 in Tyler to the late Sheban and Milady Bacile. He was a resident of Tyler most of his life. He attended Bonner Elementary School, Roberts Jr. High School, and Tyler High School. Mr. Bacile served his country in the United States Army during the Korean Conflict.
