



## Wilma Jo Gonzales

April 11, 1928 - December 29, 2015

Wilma Jo Gonzales, 87, of Tyler, Texas, died December 29, 2015 in Tyler. Mrs. Gonzales was born April 11, 1928, in Redwater, Texas. She was the daughter of George D. Banks and Josephine Parker Jackson. She graduated from Redwater School in 1946. After graduation, she moved to Dallas and started work for Sears, Roebuck & Company. She and her husband, G. G.
