With a working career of 57 years, she held various positions with many different company names, the most recent being Petrofac, CBI and McDermott (25 years) before that McEvoy, Rockwell, Smith Intl., Cameron & Cooper (32 years) but ultimately with mergers and buyouts she had only two different jobs.
