Wilmer "Wil" Edward Morgan, age 83, of Bullard, Texas departed this life on Wednesday, November 23, 2016.

Wilmer was born in Houston, Texas on August 20, 1933 to William and Elna Morgan. He grew up in Brenham, Texas, where he played varsity football and graduated from Brenham High School in 1951. He attended Blinn Junior College where he played football, before going to work for Aramco Oil Company in Saudi Arabia as a surveyor building land topography that is still used today. From there he worked for The Robert H. Ray Co. in North Africa before returning to Texas to complete his degree at Sam Houston State University. After graduation from college, Wil went to work for the Upjohn Pharmaceutical Company where he moved from sales into sales management before ending his 34-year career as a Medical science liaison in their medical research division.
